Maine Paid Family Medical Leave Program

Since being signed into law in 2024, the Paid Family and Medical Leave Rulemaking process has been at the forefront of Chamber news.

The Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature began January 3, 2024 and adjourned on Friday, May 10, 2024. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 16, the general effective date for nonemergency laws passed in the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature was Friday, August 9, 2024.

The 132nd Legislature will be sworn in on December 4th, 2024.
